UNITED STATES' UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 16(d) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, the United States of America requests that the Court enter the attached protective order limiting the disclosure of discovery materials produced in this case. In support of this Motion, the United States asserts as follows:

1. Defendant Abraham Cigarroa Cervantes was charged by Indictment on March 19, 2024, with one count of conspiracy to violate the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act ("FCPA"), in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 371, and one count of conspiracy to violate the accounting provisions of the FCPA, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 371. Indictment, ECF No. 1.

2. The Defendant was arrested in Argentina and subsequently brought to Miami on April 23, 2026. He made his initial appearance and was arraigned the following day, on April 24, 2026. ECF No. 10.

3. Discovery in this matter includes documents and materials containing personal, confidential, identifying information of individuals, which is described as "Covered Information."

4. To comply with its discovery obligations, the United States intends to provide Covered Information to counsel for the Defendant.

5. The United States seeks to protect such Covered Information from misuse and proposes the accompanying Protective Order to limit and otherwise govern the disclosure and use of Covered Information.

6. Undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for the Defendant, Jeffrey S. Weiner, Esq., who advised that the Defendant does not oppose the relief requested in this motion.

WHEREFORE, the United States respectfully requests that this Court enter the attached proposed Protective Order.
